The Nantucket Skating Club Spring Show is our end of year showcase and a crucial fundraiser. It allows us to share what we do as an organization with the community while showcasing our highest-level skaters in Solos, Duets and Trios. Participation in the Solo, Duet and Trio programs are key for a skater’s performance development, motivation and on-ice experience.

While we do follow many of the same guidelines used by other clubs to select solo skaters for shows, we take into consideration the levels we currently have at NSC and always try to include as many skaters as we can.

Solos

- Current NSC member in good standing
 - Passed **Freeskate 5**
 - Registered for full session of NSC Fall 2018 or Winter 2019 classes
 - Must participate in one of the NSC Spring Show group numbers other than Synchro or Theatre On Ice
 - * The current competitive freestyle level of each applicant will be the first criteria in qualifying for a solo.
- Next we look at each skater’s participation in competitions and USFSA tests passed as of December 31, 2018.
- *Meeting the minimum requirement does not guarantee that a skater will get a solo.**

Duets & Trios

- Current NSC member in good standing
- Passed **Freeskate 1**
- Registered for full session of NSC Fall 2018 or Winter 2019 classes
- Must participate in one of the NSC Spring Show group numbers other than Synchro or Theatre on Ice

Kristin Barone and Belinda Dorn Yancy will pair duets and trios and choose their music and/or character(s)

Application Deadline: Saturday, January 26, 2019 by 10:50am to NSC

(Application must be dropped in NSC Black Box in Nantucket Ice office or handed to Monique or Francine)
